


安全信息





2. 使用准备

插入电池

1. 滑动电池盖，打开电池门。
2. 将附带的锂电池装入电池箱中。请注意电池安装方向。
3. 装好电池后，关上电池盖。



对电池充电


第一次使用该充电电池时，请至少对该电池充电 8 小时以上。

- a) 请将摄像机处于关机状态，用附带的 USB 线将摄像机与计算机相连。
- b) 连接成功后充电指示灯变蓝，表示充电开始。充电指示灯熄灭，表示充电完成。
- c) 断开摄像机。

插入存储卡

本摄像机没有内置的存储器，不能拍照和录像。如果您想要拍照和摄像，请使用 SD 卡或 MMC 卡（本摄像机支持 SD/MMC 卡的最大容量达 32GB）。在插入或拿出存储卡前请先关机。在插卡前请确保插卡的方向正确。当插卡感觉有阻力的时候请不要强制插卡。存储卡有个写保护开关，可以防止数据被意外的删除。因此，如果你想存储或删除文件，请使写保护开关处于关的状态。

1. 使摄像机处于关机状态。
2. 在摄像机的侧面可找到橡胶盖，
打开该橡胶盖可以看到 SD 卡卡槽。
3. 如图所示插入存储卡。
4. 关闭橡胶盖。



- 如果想要取出存储卡, 请轻轻按存储卡的边缘, 然后松开, 存储卡弹出。

格式化存储卡

第一次使用本摄像机时, 请记得对存储卡进行格式化。格式化会将存储卡中所有的数据删除(包括被保护的文件)。所以在格式化前请对重要的文件进行备份。

- 1: **开启摄像机, 按【菜单】键显示菜单, 再按向【右】键进入【设置】菜单。**
- 2: 按向【上】或向【下】键选择【格式化】, 然后按【确认】键进入到该项的子菜单。
- 3: 按向【上】或向【下】键选择【是】, 然后按【确认】键将清除所有数据。


设置语言

- 4: 按【确认】键来确认日期与时间的设置并退出菜单。





3. 基本操作

打开和关闭摄像机

- 1). 打开液晶显示屏，摄像机自动开启。闭合液晶显示屏，摄像机将关闭。
- 2). 您也可以按【电源】键开启摄像机，再次按【电源】键3秒可关闭摄像机。

为了节省电池电量，您可以通过【设置】菜单中的【自动关机】功能来设置自动关机的时间。

模式转换

本摄像机有四种模式。按【模式】键来改变本摄像机的录制模式。每按一次【模式】键摄像机的模式将改变一次。

录像

- 3: 按【快门】键开始录像。

- 5: 再次按【快门】键停止录制。如果存储卡的内存已满，本摄像机将自动停止录制。

- 液晶显示屏的上方显示已录制的时间。
- 当光线不足时，可按【向右/补光 LED】键来打开补光灯，当光线足够时，再次按【向右/补光 LED】键将关闭补光灯。

拍照

- 1: 设置摄像机为拍照模式，液晶显示屏显示图标()。
- 2: 数字变焦：
按【放大】或【缩小】键来放大或缩小液晶显示屏上的图片。数字变焦的倍数级别将显示在液晶显示屏上。
- 3: 坚稳地握住摄像机并按【快门】键进行拍照。

录音

- 1: 开启摄像机并将摄像机设置为录音模式()。
- 2: 按【快门】键开始录音。
- 3: 再次按【快门】键停止录制。如果存储卡的内存已满，本摄像机将自动停止录制。

4. 设置摄像机

当屏幕显示菜单时，使用向【上】/【下】/【左】/【右】/【确认】键来对该选项进行设置。录音模式没有菜单。

回放录像

- 4: 按【快门】键结束播放视频。
- 5: 按向【上】或向【下】键来调整音量大小。

回放照片

- 1: 按【回放】键将摄像机设置为回放模式。
最后录制的文件将显示在液晶显示屏上, 如果存储卡里没有文件液晶显示屏将显示“无文件”。
- 2: 按向【左】或向【右】键来浏览上一张或下一张图像。
- 3: 缩放键:
按【放大】或【缩小】键来放大或缩小照片。当照片放大后, 您可按【确认】键进入移动模式, 使用向【左】/【右】/【上】/【下】键来查看浏览图片的细节。

6. 建立连接

将摄像机与普通电视机相连

将电视机和摄像机相连，摄像机的液晶显示屏将关闭，电视机相当于摄像机的液晶显示屏。

1. 用附带的AV线将电视机和摄像机相连。
2. 开启摄像机和电视机，将电视机的模式设置为“AV”模式。
3. 当摄像机设置为录制模式时（包括拍照、录像、录音模式）你可以通过电视机来浏览被拍摄的物体。
4. 当摄像机处于回放模式时，你可以通过电视机来浏览和播放已录制的图片，录像和录音文件。

将摄像机与高清电视相连

1. 用高清数据线连接摄像机和高清电视。
2. 打开高清电视，将电视的模式调整为 HDMI 模式。
3. 开启摄像机，当摄像机设置为拍照模式时（可选择五种分辨率尺寸：



4. 将摄像机的模式调整为回放模式。你可以通过电视机来浏览和播放已录制的图片，录像和录音文件。

7. 按【确认】按键暂停播放，再次按【确认】按键继续播放。

9. 向【上】或向【下】键来调整音量。

将图像下载到计算机

有两种方法可以将图像从摄像机的存储卡下载到计算机中：

- 将 SD 卡插入读卡器中
- 用附带的 USB 线将摄像机和电脑相连。



使用读卡器

1. 从摄像机中弹出存储卡然后将其插入到电脑的读卡器中。
2. 打开【我的电脑】或 windows 资源管理器，然后双击代表存储卡的可移动图标。

3. 将图像从存储卡上复制到计算机中你选择的目录下。

通过 USB 线将摄像机连接到计算机

1: 用附带的 USB 线将摄像机连接到计算机的 USB 端口上，开启摄像机，

当摄像机与计算机成功连接后，液晶显示屏上显示“移动硬盘”的图标。

注：

- 若要进入 PC CAMERA 模式，请按以下步骤操作：

首先长按快门键几秒，然后用 USB 线将摄像机与电脑相连。开启摄像机，
当摄像机与计算机成功连接后，液晶显示屏上显示“PC CAMERA”图标。

2: 打开【我的电脑】或 windows 资源管理器，然后双击代表存储卡的可移
动图标。所有的文件存储在一个名为“DCIM”的文件夹中。

2. Preparing for using

Installing the Battery

1. Slide the battery cover and open it.
2. Place the accessory li-ion battery into the compartment. Note that the metallic contacts must be aligned with the contacts in the compartment.
3. After the battery is properly installed, close the battery cover.



Charging the battery

Please charge the battery at least 8 hours for first time use.


- a) Power OFF and connect the USB cable to the camcorder and the computer for battery charging.
- b) Charging starts when charging LED turns BLUE. The charge indicator light turns OFF when charging is completed.
- c) Disconnect the camcorder.

Inserting the Memory Card

This camcorder has no internal memory, it can't record pictures or movie clips. If you want record more you have to use a SD or MMC card (The MAX.SD/MMC card that this camcorder could support is up to 32GB). Turn off the camcorder before inserting or removing the memory card. Be sure to orient the card correctly when inserting it. Never try to force the memory card into the slot when you feel resistance. The memory card has a write protect switch which used to protect data from accidental deletion. Therefore, whenever you want to record, format or delete files in the SD card, disable the write protection beforehand.

7. Turn off the camcorder.
8. Find the rubber cover at the side of camcorder and then you will see the SD card slot.

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9. Insert the memory card as illustrated.
 10. Close the rubber cover.
- **To release the memory card, press the edge of the card gently.**

Format the memory card

It is important to format the memory card when first time use this camcorder. All data will be deleted including protected files. Be sure to download the important files to your computer before formatting.

- 1: Turn the power on, and set the camcorder to the Setup Menu.
- 2: Press the **UP** or **DOWN** buttons to select [**Format**], then press **OK** button to launch the submenu.
- 3: Press the **UP** or **DOWN** buttons to select the item [**YES**] and then press the **OK** button to erase all data.

Setting the Language







▪ **Connecting the Camcorder to a TV**

When plug in the TV-out cable (supplied) to the camcorder AV out jack the LCD screen turns black, Connect the camcorder to a TV and the TV screen now performs as the camcorder LCD screen.

1. Connect the camcorder to a TV via the TV-out cable (supplied).
2. Turn on the TV and the camcorder, and then set the TV to "AV" mode.
3. When the camcorder is set to record mode, you can preview the subjects you want to record on the TV screen.

4. When the camcorder is set to Playback mode, you can review all the pictures, video and audio clips stored in the camera on the TV.

Connecting the Camcorder to a HDTV

HD-TV hereby means the HDTV built-in component input ports, thus can perform HD (720P) high resolution quality while connected.

1. Connect the camcorder to HDTV by the HDMI-cable.
2. Power on HDTV and switch to HDMI-mode.
3. Power ON the camcorder. Set the camcorder in playback mode.
Push the joystick leftward or rightward to select the file demanded.
4. Press **SHUTTER** button to "Play" the selected video file on HDTV,
press the **SHUTTER** button again to "Stop" the playing.
5. Press the **OK** button to "Pause", press it again to "Continue" the playing.
6. Press the **LEFT** button to reward, press the **RIGHT** button to forward.
7. Press the **UP** or **DOWN** button to adjust the volume.


Connecting the Camcorder to a PC

There are two ways to download files from the camcorder's internal memory or memory card to a computer:

- By inserting the memory card into a card reader
- By connecting the camera to a computer using the supplied USB cable.

Using a Card Reader

- 1: Eject the memory card from the camcorder and insert it into a card reader that is connected to a computer.
- 2: Open [My Computer] or [Windows Explorer] and double-click the removable disk icon that represents the memory card.
- 3: Copy images from the card into a directory of your choice on the computer's hard disk.



Connecting the Camcorder to a PC with the USB Cable

- 1: Connect the supplied USB cable to the computer's USB port and turn on the camcorder. An icon "Mass storage" appears on the screen when Connection to the computer has been successfully completed. Please ensure that there is SD card in the camcorder. Since the camcorder is without the internal memory, there will be no content to view connecting the camcorder to the PC.

Note: If you want to enter PC CAM mode, at first you have to hold and press the shutter button for a few seconds, then connect the camcorder to the computer with the supplied USB cable. An icon "PC CAM" will appear on the screen. If not, please continue to press the shutter button and press the power button as well. An icon "PC CAM" appears on the screen. Open [My Computer], there will be a file named "USB video tool". Double click the

icon. The camcorder will work as the webcam.

- 2: Open [My Computer] or [Windows Explorer]. A "Removable Disk" appears in the drive list. Double-click the "Removable Disk" icon to view its contents. Files stored on the camera are located in the folder named "DCIM".
- 3: Copy the photos or files to your computer.
