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General tips for GPS application

The following content is tips for GPS device application and operation. Please read it before starting use of the GPS device, so that you may make a better use of the GPS device.

- While the GPS device is working, it receives signal from satellites for positioning. The signal from satellite may not be received, or be weakened in room, nearby some big buildings, or under overhead bridges.
- When the GPS device is receiving satellite signals, you will get signals from different satellites when you are in different places, this is called "Satellite Path", a "Satellite Path" only covers a range of 300 KM. If a "Satellite Path" is defined at place A, then turn off the device and move to another place beyond 300 KM away from A, the device is under another "Satellite Path", At this moment, the device needs to search for satellite signal again. To track the new "Satellite Path", this will take quite a long time. To save time for this searching, you may click "GPS Reset" button in menu of "GPS Testing" to clear the previous "Satellite Path".
- It will be difficult and taking more time to catch positioning signal from satellite during high speed driving. It is suggested to search the positioning signal by stopping your car for a better and safer effect.
- While charging the device, please only use the travel charger or car charger equipped by the manufacturer in its original package. Other chargers may cause damage to this device, and this damage is not covered by our warranty.

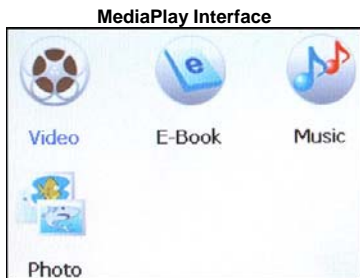

Illustrations on screen display:

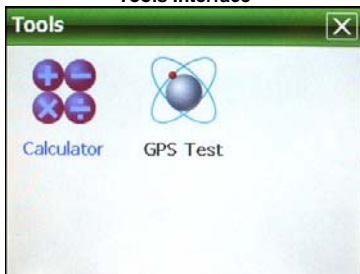


From this interface, click the small icon to switch to the corresponding page. Then, an animation is played circularly on the screen. Touch the screen or the small icon on the bottom to enter the function.

Tools Interface



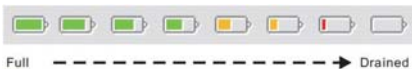
Setting Interface

Battery

Battery Status Icon:



When the battery is at low power level, please charge it immediately to ensure the device work normally.

Charging:

Warnings for charging:

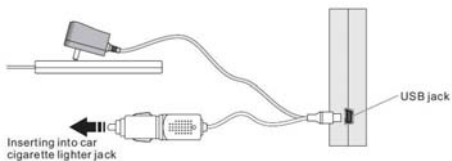
1. A new battery may be empty and not charged before you get the device.
2. To achieve the best performance of the battery, it is better to charge it up to 8 hours in the first three times, but not over 16 hours.
3. In normal charging with DC charger, please make sure to charge it for 2 – 2.5 hours to get it fully charged.



- A new battery will reach its best performance after few cycles of charging and discharging.
- If the device is not used for long time, it is better to charge it to full capacity every 2 or 3 months during storage.
- If not using the device for a long time, it is wise to take out the battery.

Charger Application:

- DC Charger:
Take out the DC charger, plug it into the wall outlet with AC 220V (100V~240V), then plug in the DC jack into the device DC-in jack.(see the illustration below).
- Car Lighter Charger:
Please insert the car charger into car cigarette lighter jack, then plug into the USB jack (see the illustration below).



When you use car charger, please start car engine first, and then connect it to the device to avoid possible damage to the device due to overloaded pulse current during ignition. Please pull it out when you stop the engine, and plug it in again after next ignition.

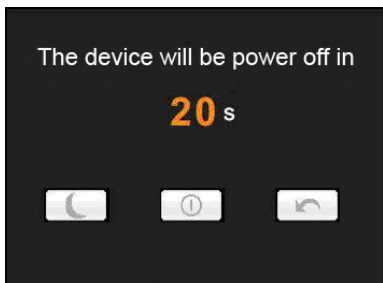
Power On/Off the device




Power On the device

Press and hold the power on/off button for 3-5 seconds to power on the device.

Sleeping & Power –off

Press the power on/off button for 3-5 seconds during the device is on, the interface will be shown as below:



Click the icon  to go to the sleeping mode; click the icon  to power off; click the icon  to cancel and back to normal operation.

Function & Operation

Video Playback




This feature is for video file playing, with the formats: AVI, MPEG,MPG, ASX, DAT,ASF and WMV.

From mediaplay interface, click  icon to enter into Video Playback function as shown below:



Click  button to search video files not listed in the appointed video file folder;
Click  button to close and exit from Video Playback application; Double click or select and click  button to open and play this file.

This is for Music Playback with format of MP3, WMA, WAV.

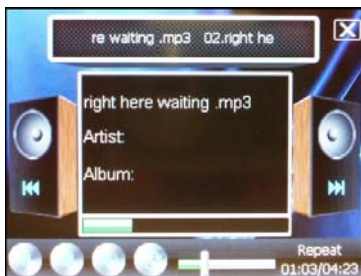
Operation:

Click  button to search for music files not in selected folder; click  button to close this window and exit musi play mode; double click, or select then click  button to play this music file. Music play mode is displayed as following diagrams:



Button and control in Play Mode:

In music playback mode, click  icon to pause, the icon will change to , click  icon again to resume, click  icon to stop; click  icon to jump to the next one, click  icon to jump to the previous one; click  icon to switch on/off repeat mode; click  icon to set mute, the icon will change to , click  again to resume.

This is for Photo Display with format JPG stored in an SD card.

Operation:



From mediaplay interface, click  icon to enter into Photo Display function as shown below:











Click  icon to search photo files not listed in the appointed photo file folder;


click  icon to close and exit Photo Display function; double click or click  icon to open or play the file as shown below:



Operation under photo view

Click  or  icon to select previous or next photos; Click  or  icon to zoom in or zoom out; Click  icon for full screen display. In full screen display, tap the screen again to resume; Click  icon to resume the picture to original ratio; Click  icon to rotate the picture; Click  icon to start picture slide show, during slide show, tap the screen to resume.

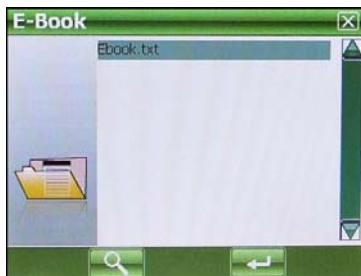
Click the button  on top right corner to exit.




eBook Reading

This is for eBook Reading with format .txt stored in an SD card.



Operation:

From mediaplay interface, click  button to enter into eBook Reading application as shown below:



Click  icon to search for txt files not in selected folder; click  icon to close this window and exit; double click, or click  icon after selected to open the TXT file as shown below:




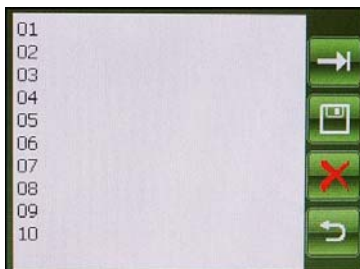
Click  or  icon to turn page up or down; "Auto./Manual" is for selecting automatic or manual page turning; "Capital" is for big size of font display; "Small letter" is for small size of font display.





Bookmark

This is for bookmark in reading a voluminous article, marking or jumping to the last time marked page, a humanized design for convenience while reading.

Operation:

In eBook Reading mode, click  icon to enter into bookmark setting, display of dialogueblock is shown as below:

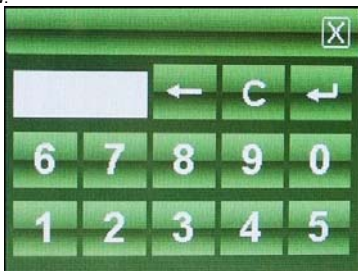





Press  icon to save the current page as a bookmark. Directly press dialog box to select the saved bookmark, press  icon to delete the selected bookmark; press  icon to load the selected bookmark. Press  icon to exit bookmark function.

Jump to the appointed page

This is for jumping to the appointed page when reading a voluminous article and no bookmark is set.

Operation: In eBook Reading mode, click  icon to enter into Jump function as shown below:



Tap the number key on screen to input the page number, click  icon to backspace; click  icon to clear input block; click  icon to jump to the selected page number.

Calculator

This device has two calculators: Ordinary and Scientific calculator, able to be switched at any time, a good assistant for your work and study.


Operation:

In the Tools interface, click the icon  to activate the function of Calculator.



As shown in the above illustration, the calculators can be used like normal others. Click "Scientific/Ordinary" on the right to switch between Scientific Calculator and Ordinary Calculator; the unit of calculation of the right can be taken according to actual demand.

Exit Calculator Mode


In Calculator mode, click  icon at the top right corner of the screen to exit and return to the Tools interface.

System Setting

This is for system setting to change default setting of the system to your personal preference.

Operation:



From system main interface, click  icon to enter into system setting as shown below:

There are ten options in setting mode, click each option to change the particulars.

Click  icon to switch the pages, click  icon to exit.

Language

There are three languages option icons shown as below:




Click the corresponding language icon, the system will save the changing automatically when the setup is closed, and return to the previous menu.

Brightness

This is for changing the brightness of the screen and screen saver.




After changing, click  icon to exit and save the setting.

Power

This is for setting auto sleep time.



Select time from the drag menu to active the auto sleep function, press power on/off button to resume, it is disable when "No" is selected. After changing, click  icon to exit and save the setting.

Sounds

This function is for setting start-up music and screen touch sound, as shown below:



Tick "Screen Sound" to enable or disable the sound of screen operations.


Click the different options from turn on sound to audition the start-up sound and the general volume can be adjusted by dragging the slide directly.

Customized sound

From sounds setting mode, click "Customize Sound " the window come out as shown below:




"Nand Flash" is the built-in memory of the device; "SDMMC" is the SD card.

Select one music file from either one of the memory, click the icon  to confirm.

Time Setting

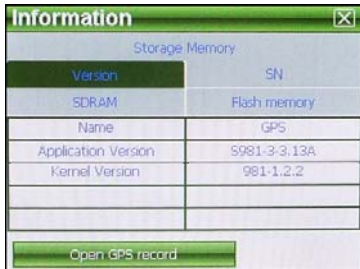
This is for setting time of the system. After entering into this UI, screen display is shown as the illustration below:



From this interface, click the icons on the screen to adjust. After setting, click  icon to exit and save.

Information

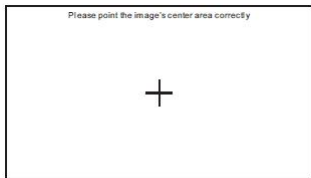
This is for checking system resources:



From this interface, click “Version”, “SN”, “SDRAM” and “Flash memory” icons to check the corresponding information.

Coordinates Calibration

This is for calibrating the stylus coordinates on touch screen. After entering it is shown as below:





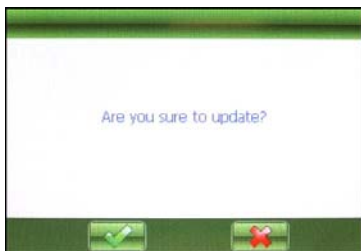
Use stylus to tap at the center of the cross, and then tap on other crosses which will move after each tapping until finish and "Touch Screen Calibration Completed" is shown.

Update Logo

The function is for updating start-up logo of the device. Please make sure that the logo pictures name "Logo" has been saved into the SD card and the resolution is 320 X 240. After entering, it is shown as below:



Click  icon, you may see this upgrade file. During upgrade operation, click  icon to start to update logo as shown below:



Click  icon to cancel or click  icon to start updating.



Warning: please make sure the battery is full when it is updating. Otherwise, please charge the device fully.

GPS Path

Using this function is to set GPS path for your navigation. Screen display will be shown as below:



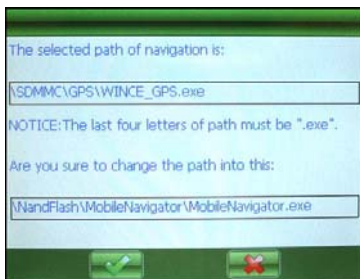
Select GPS Software



If there is more than one map from different companies in an SD card, this feature can help you select each of them easily.

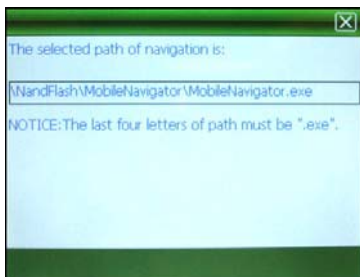
In SD card directory root, open the file folder to find the map to be used, select navigation software which the extension name is .exe. (which has different names from different companies, please refer to the details from each companies of these navigation software. e.g. Careland has WINCE_GPS.exe), then select and click

Click  icon to cancel; click  icon to accept and the window will come out as shown below:



Click  icon on top right corner to return to GPS path interface.

USB

"MASS STORAGE": Connect to computer as a U disk.

"ACTIVESYNC": Connect to computer for programming debug.



Click the expect option and click  icon to exit and save.


Services

Returning to Win CE Desktop

The device can return to the Win CE by pressing one key and implement the PDA functions.

Operation Procedure:



From the system main interface, click  icon and the screen pops up the confirmation dialog box. Click OK to return to the Win CE desktop.

From Win CE desktop, click  icon to start the navigation system.

Trouble Shooting

No.	Problem	Possible Cause	Solutions
1	Can not power on	Battery drained (The screen has no further display after a blink when pressing power on button.)	Please refer to the description of battery charging in this manual, only use the enclosed charger to charge the device.
2	Hangs up	The start interface stays on the screen for long time without changing.	Take out the battery, then put it back, start the device again.
		No display of the screen, or display on screen is frozen as any button is pressed.	Press and hold the power on button for 5 seconds, then release it to power on. Take out the battery, then put it back, start the device again.
3	Error in upgrade	Dead or frozen during upgrade, display on the screen is frozen and no button works.	This fault can only be fixed by the manufacturer. Please return for repair.
4	Can not charge	During charging, the	Make sure the charger
